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## About AFS Kenya – Organization For Intercultural Education

SWAHILI RESOURCE CENTRE (SRC) was the backbone of Organization For Intercultural Education (AFS Kenya / OFIE). SRC was registered in March 2005 with a mission to promote and preserve Swahili culture.

SRC became the main host of AFS exchange programs when the program was introduced in Kenya in 2008 and signed a Memorandum of Understanding with AFS International to participate in the Kennedy-Lugar Youth Exchange and Study program.

Organization for Intercultural Education (OFIE) was officially registered in May 2008 and it was not until April 2011 when

the organization was able to detach itself from SRC and move to a newly established office along Makadara Road in Mombasa Kenya.



## CULTURAL ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM

The Program combines intensive language classes for 90 hours, School interaction program, placements in host family, participation in community activities allowing you to live the cultural and socioeconomic realities of your host country, exciting excursion and Safari tours and rural life experience!





### **Cultural English Language Program offers:**

- + Seven weeks to provide opportunity for the student-PARTICIPANTS to engage themselves in spoken English with students, teachers and adult citizen of Kenya. There will be a general 90 contact hours of English language classes.
- + The classes is followed by field based assignments, such as shopping, helping in the old age homes where English is the spoken language, interviewing people on their everyday life.
- + Home-stay where the families speak English. This will be 90 contact hours of Intensive English language classes.
- + Periodic community service program for the students in projects such as environmental clubs, orphanages and youth programs. Students will be engaged in these programs together with KL-YES Alumni or returnees.
- + Experience of a rural life, staying in a work camp and participate in self-help project, such as tree planting, water project within the rural areas.
- + Exciting Excursions trips on the week-ends, visiting Museums, Archaeological sites and monuments. Additional opportunities for students to make 2 night as part of TP cost three days Safari tour of Tsavo National Park.
- + At the end of the program students will undertake an examination that is ACTFL rating
