What should I bring?

Generally, attire during the program is very casual. Kenyan people are generally very warm, open and hospitable, if uncertain, it is always better to ask. Pack warm clothing for cooler nights.

Boys normally wear jeans with T-shirts, light material trousers and light shirts. Girls wear long skirts to the knee, blouse at least with sleeves, long trousers..

While in Nairobi, the weather around July period is pretty cool (it's our coolest!) to our standard. Temperature range from 66°F to 52°F.

All accommodation, meals and excursions are included in the price. You will, however, need some spending pocket money for souvenirs and gifts.
