

## Learning Styles Inventory Scoring

**STEP 1:** To compute your scores, first record your totals from each column as shown before. Each column corresponds to a specific learning style.

Column 1 (Concrete Experience- CE): \_\_\_\_\_

Column 2 (Reflective Observation- RO): \_\_\_\_\_

Column 3 (Abstract Conceptualization- AC): \_\_\_\_\_

Column 4 (Active Experimentation- AE): \_\_\_\_\_

**STEP 2:** Alone, these labels do not tell us much about our preferences, so it is necessary to calculate combined scores. To do this, subtract CE from AC, and RO from AE as shown:

1.  $AC - CE = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

2.  $AE - RO = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

**STEP 3:** Next, take the two numbers from *Step 2*, and use them to plot a coordinate on the grid below. Use the first number for the Y-axis (vertical), and the second number as the X-axis (horizontal). The quadrant in which your point lands, indicates the type of learner you are based on this inventory.
