Your Project

- The Werkstatt Sutthausen is one of the approximately 16 workshops of the Heilpädagogische Hilfe Osnabrück in which adults with a disability can participate in the labour market. It offers a wide range of activities and occupational fields for professional development: electrical engineering and assembly, garden maintenance, wood and metalworking, packaging, gastronomy and service or office services are just a few examples.
- One of the great goals is the self-determined participation of people with disabilities in all areas of society.
- They are furthermore organizing leisure and sports activities and also therapies
- Approx. 1.700 employees work on this every day in educational and promotional institutions, workshops and working groups, in various forms of housing and care, in consulting and administration.
- There are about 10 more volunteers in the field every year. All volunteers should find each other as a team, attend training courses together and support each other.

Location

- located in the west of Germany
- Osnabrück is a vivid student city and also called the “city of peace”
- There are shopping opportunities, museums, cinemas, restaurants bars and a lot more cultural offerings

You should...

- ... be open to work with people with disabilities
- ... possess empathy and be willing to get involved with people
- ... be a team player

Tasks, you may perform

- You are placed in one of three groups within the workshop
- The group embraces adults of all genders, ages and degree of disability
- Support for the self-sufficiency of people with disabilities (assisting them to eat, drink, shop)
- Giving support in the daily work routine
- Pick up the people from the bus station and welcome them
- Support for work-accompanying measures (sports, art, therapies)
- Collaboration in the group service and support of work pedagogues, nurses for curative education and production assistants in the daily work routine
- Support in nursing procedures



You will learn

- The project can show young people the first steps towards an inclusive society.
- Young people have the opportunity to get to know the people “behind the handicap” in order to reduce possible reservations and prejudices and to learn how to deal with this target group as a matter of course.
- Self-confidence
- Responsibility

Working hours

- 38 hours of work per week
- You will have 30 days of vacation

Accommodation

- You will stay in a single-room in a student dormitory in the city of Osnabrück
- You are welcome to eat lunch five days a week within the project

Extras

- monthly ticket for public transportation
- Monthly pocket money of 110 €
- Possibility in taking part of the Hanse Fit-Programm (company sports) and further training opportunities
- The project requires a hepatitis vaccination (if missing, it's going to be carried out by the company's physician)
