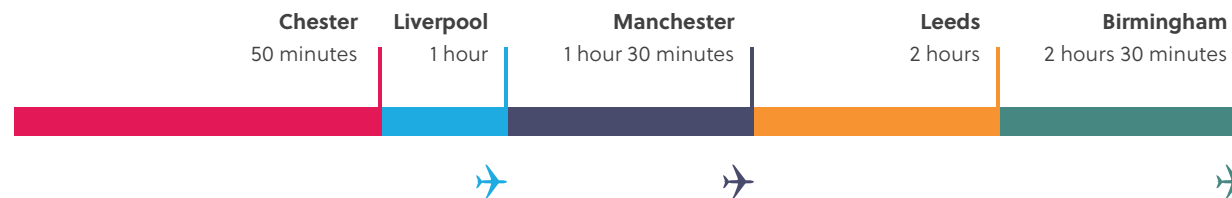

Sports

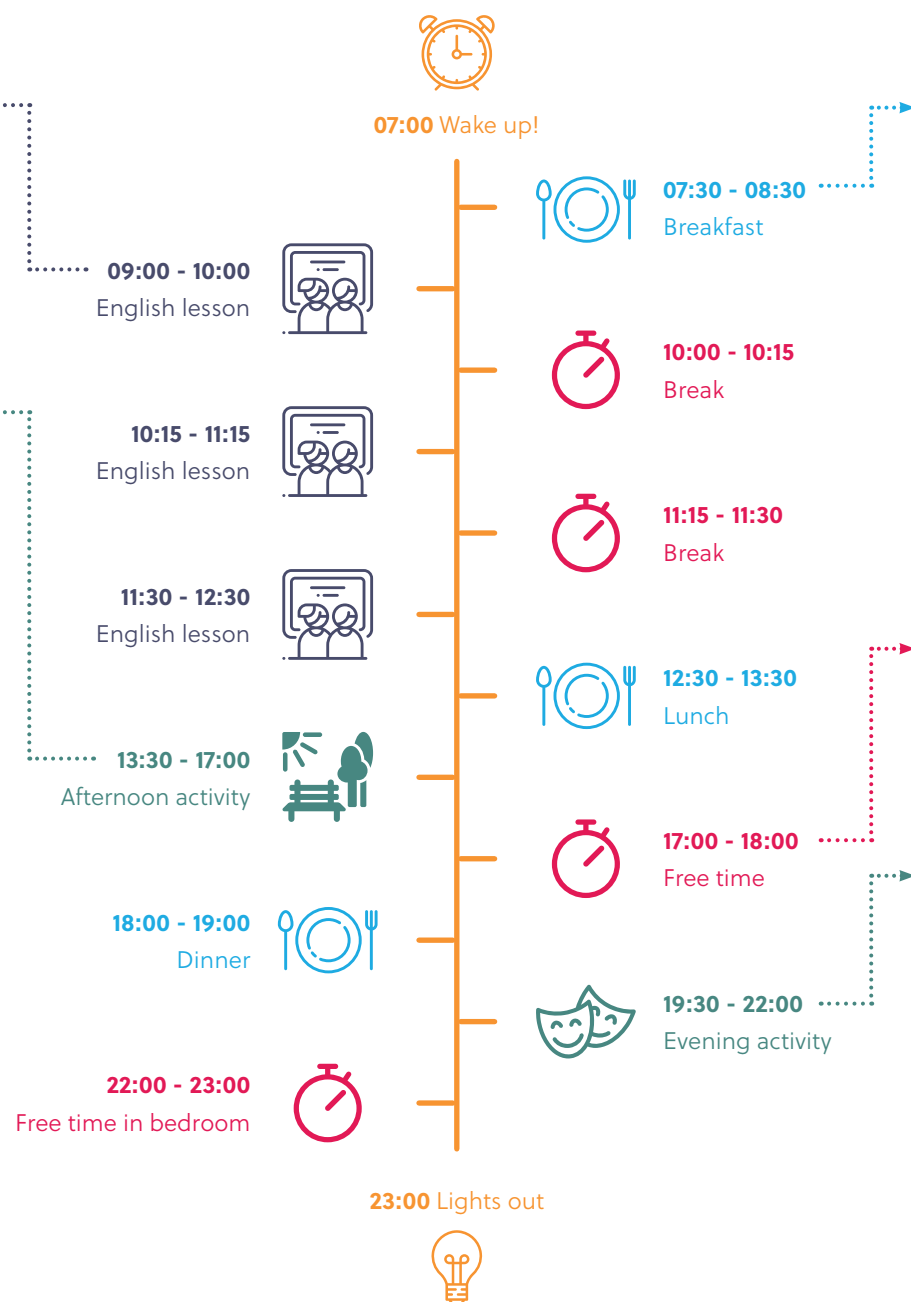
Football, badminton, basketball, tennis, swimming, sailing, beach games

Population: 55,268,100.

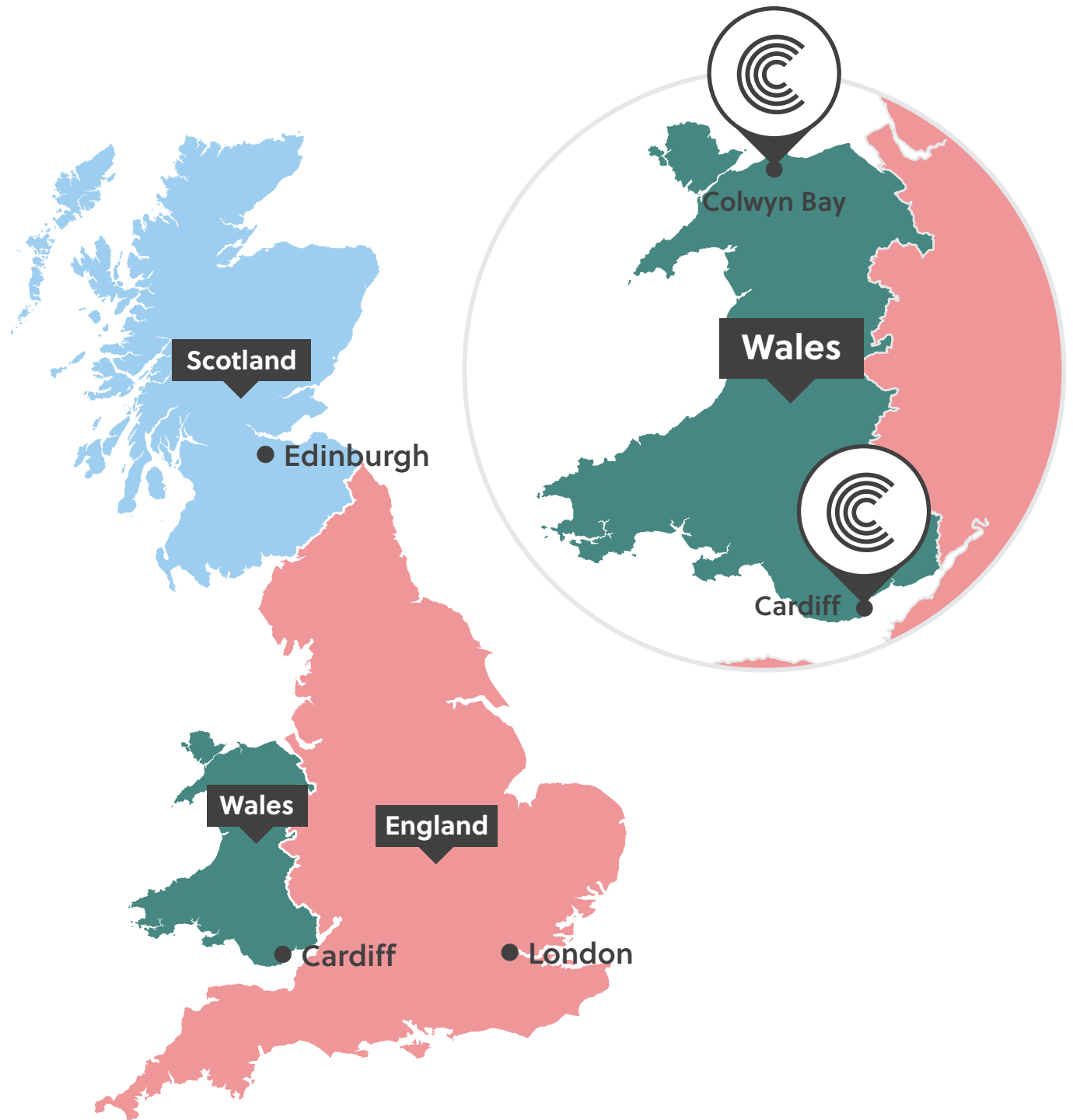
The capital city is London.

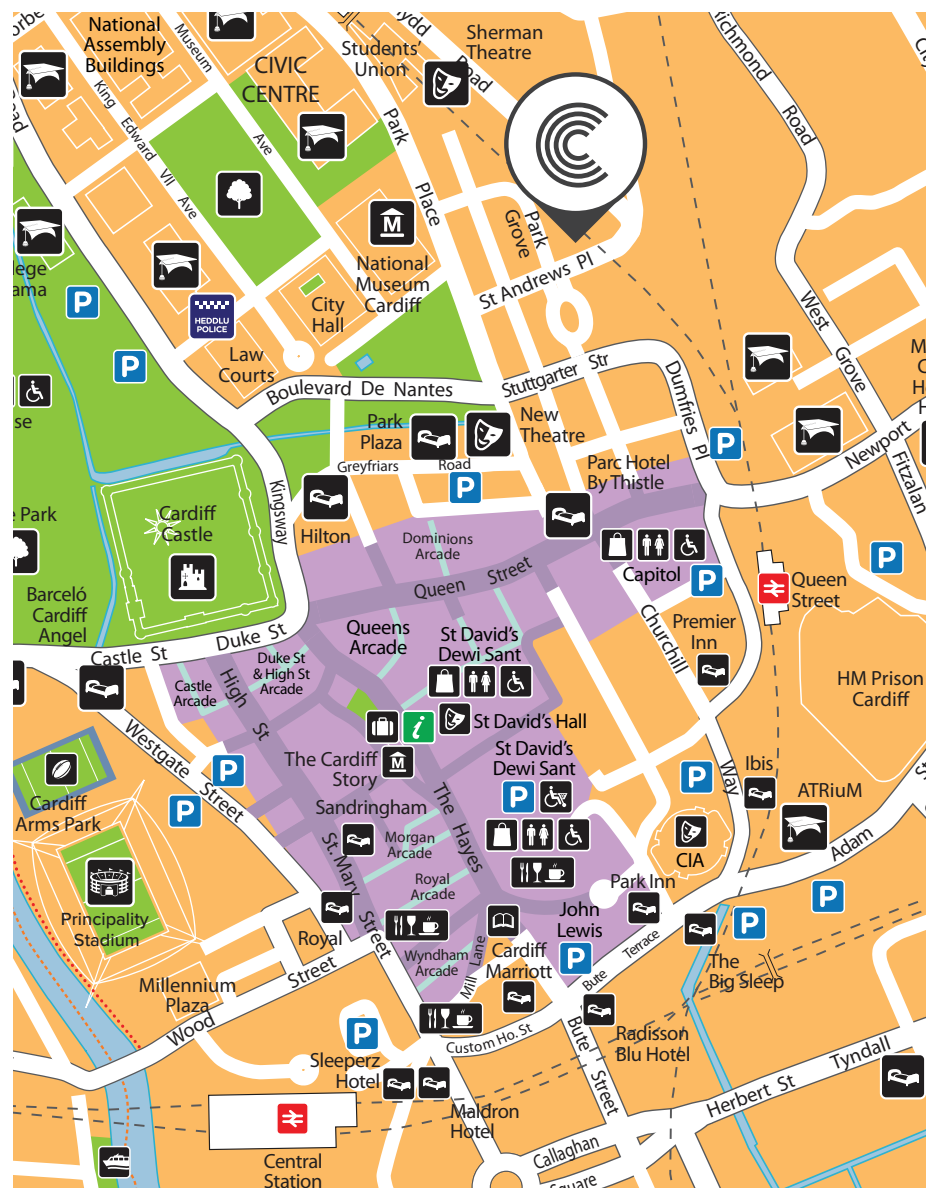
Population: 5,404,700.
