

WHAT DOES AFS PAY FOR?

<u>Way to school</u> <i>Public transportation travel ticket/card</i>	✓	Paid if the distance between home and school is over 3 km.
<u>Way to school</u> <i>Kilometer allowance for driving own car</i>	✗	Paid only in special cases and if agreed ahead of time. Maximum reimbursement is 150 € per month.
<u>School books</u>	✓	If school still uses paper books, check with the AFS office if the book is available to loan.
<u>E-book licences</u>	✓	The digital material for basic studies will be replaced from autumn 2024.
<u>Finnish language studies</u> <i>Class fee</i>	✓	Maximum 80 € per student during the entire program.
<u>Finnish language studies</u> <i>Travel to class and/or class materials</i>	✗	If the class fee is under 80 €, you may be reimbursed for travel and/or class materials, until the 80 € maximum is full.
<u>Travel to mandatory orientations</u> <i>Public transportation</i>	✓	
<u>Travel to mandatory orientations</u> <i>Kilometer allowance for driving own car</i>	✗	Paid only in special cases and if agreed ahead of time.
<u>Travel to events organised by local chapter, school etc.</u>	✗	Not paid.
<u>Travel to personal hobbies</u>	✗	Not paid.
<u>Medical expenses</u>	✓	Doctor visits that are due to an accident or getting sick are paid. Specialist visits/tests are paid when referred to by doctor. Please note! EU students may also use public health care.
<u>Dental expenses</u>	✓	Only expenses due to acute pain relief are paid.
