Dear exchange student

If you want to travel during your exchange, the first step is to speak with your host family or local chapter about your wish to travel. Next, you must comply with travel rules of AFS Denmark as travel without permission can affect the participation of your program.

Traveling abroad or overnight stays in public accommodation such as hostels or hotels requires a written permission from your natural parents. For this reason, your travel request must be submitted to AFS no later than 2 weeks before your desired departure date.

In the next steps, your host family and local chapter need to approve your trip. If and when your trip is approved, AFS Denmark will work to obtain a travel permission from your natural parents.
