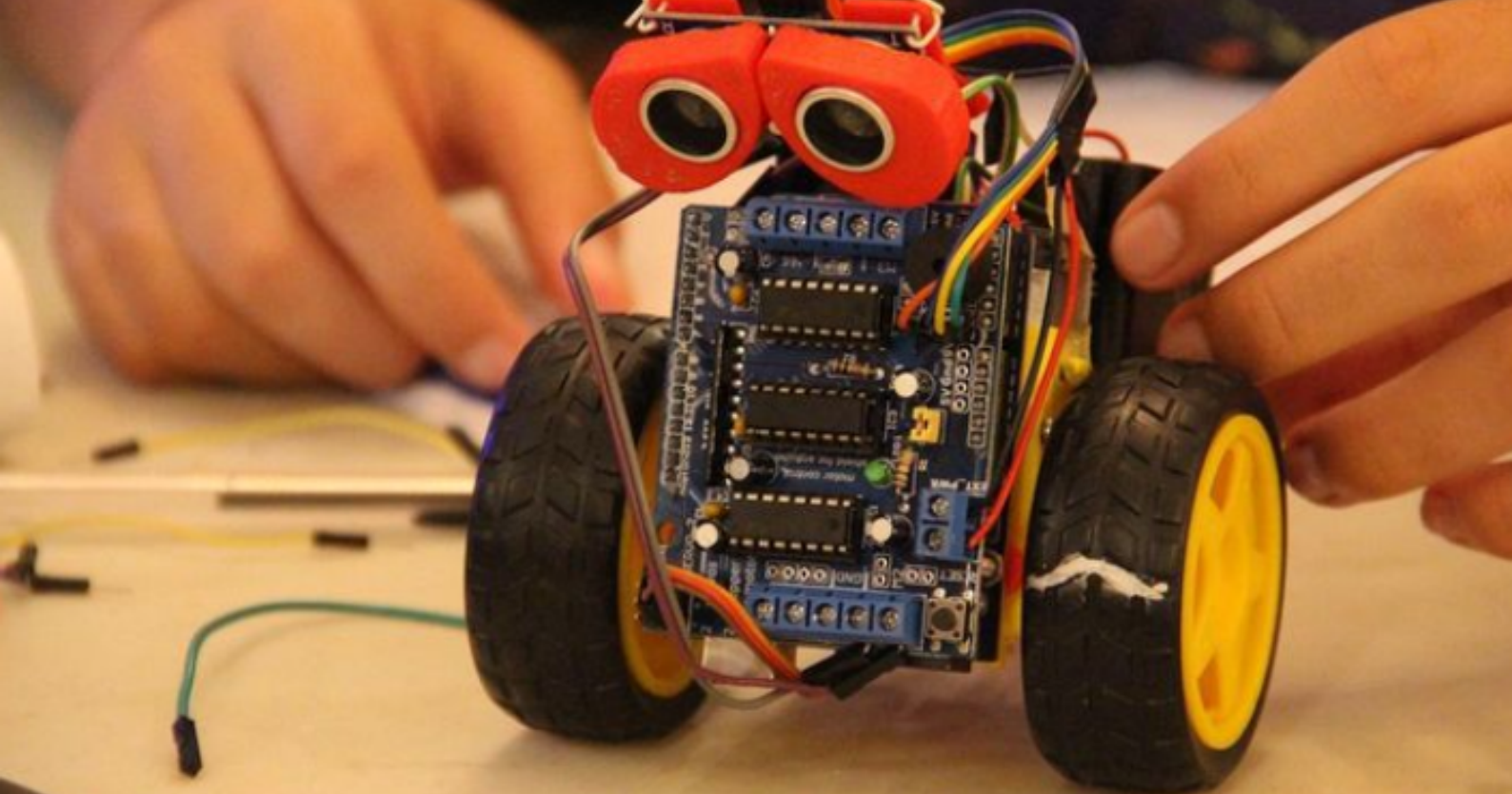


BENJAMIN FRANKLIN SCIENCE CORNER

What do they do?

- Provide specific technical assistance and adapted materials to support educational inclusion.
- Train professionals in issues related to visual impairment.
- Raise society's awareness of the potential of visually impaired people.

Offers support in specific areas to students who are enrolled in kindergarten or elementary school. The included student attends the Resource Center at a time opposite to his/her regular schooling, for a period of 2 to 4 hours once a week. They are also provided with canes, guidelines, abacuses, pointers, and Perkins typewriters (on loan) among other support elements.

This unit also provides:

- Technical assistance to teachers of Inclusive Schools through weekly visits.
- Curricular adaptation according to the Ministry of Education and Culture regulations.
- Support and training for families.
- Awareness and information workshops for teachers of inclusive schools.

Municipalidad de Ciudad del Este (CDE)



MUNICIPALIDAD DE CDE

Due to its population and economic sector, the municipality of Ciudad del Este is the second most important city in Paraguay, it is the capital of the Department of Alto Paraná and is located 327 km from the country's capital. It is the largest city within the region called Triple Border. The municipality was founded by decree on February 3, 1957.
