1. From India to Russia (Sending)- November 2018
2. From Russia to India (Hosting)-Sep/Oct 2018

Volunteer Exchange Program to Hungary

Hungary is one of the 15 most popular tourist destinations in the world, with a [capital](#) regarded as one of the [most beautiful in the world](#). Despite its relatively small size, Hungary has numerous World Heritage Sites, UNESCO Biosphere reserves, the second largest thermal lake in the world (Lake Hévíz), the largest lake in Central Europe ([Lake Balaton](#)), and the largest natural grassland in Europe ([Hortobágy](#)). Hungary has a rich [folk](#) crafts tradition, for example: [embroidery](#), decorated [pottery](#) and [carvings](#).

Hosting Cities: Different Chapters of Hungary

Program dates:

1. From India to Hungary (Sending): October 20- November 4th, 2018
2. From Hungary to India (Hosting): April/May 2019

Expectation from the participating Indian volunteers:

1. INT and domestic travel cost to the Host chapter in Russia/Hungary and visa cost of the country (Russia/Hungary)
2. Host the Russian/Hungarian Volunteer and take care of the Cultural visits, hosting program schedule, and the Inter-chapter travel cost (if any)

Eligibility Criteria:

1. One must be a registered volunteer and active – both at local level and/or national level for at least 2 and more year.
2. Preference will be given to those who have not participated in any exchange program earlier
3. One must continue being active in the chapter for a minimum of 1 year after attending this Volunteer Exchange Program

Important Note:

1. The Agenda and Eligibility criteria are subject to change depending on the requirement of the partner country
2. The volunteer is required to share a report about the exchange upon their return from the program from partner country
