## Kenya Cultural English Language Program

JULY – AUGUST

### PROGRAMME INFORMATION



*Are you interested in learning about Kenyan culture and improving your English while contributing to a community in need? Or maybe you are looking for a different way of spending your summer? Choose the program and destination that fits your goals and expectations and live an experience of a lifetime!*

#### Cultural English Language Program offers:

- Seven weeks to provide opportunity for the student-participants to engage themselves in spoken English with students, teachers and adult citizens of Kenya. There will be 90 contact hours of intensive English language classes.
- The classes are followed by field based assignments, such as shopping, helping in the old age homes where English is the spoken language, interviewing people on their everyday life.
- Home-stay where the families speak English.
- Periodic community service program for the students.
- Experience of a rural life, staying in a work camp and participate in a self-help project, such as tree planting or a water project within the rural areas.
- Exciting excursion trips during the week-ends
- Certification of program students after undertake an ACTFL test

The 28-day programme is designed for High School students aged 14 - 17 who are interested to learn English in an intensive and cultural set-up in Kenya. This is a summer program that runs between July and August.

Who can apply?

- Anyone aged between 14 and 17. Minimum per group is 15, maximum is 25.

What should I bring?

Generally, attire during the program is very casual. Kenyan people are generally very warm, open and hospitable, if uncertain, it is always better to ask. Pack warm clothing for cooler nights.

Boys normally wear jeans with T-shirts, light material trousers and light shirts. Girls wear long skirts to the knee, blouse at least with sleeves, long trousers..

The weather around July period is relatively cooler than usual. Temperature range from 66°F to 52°F. However in National Parks it may be dry and dusty.

All accommodation, meals and excursions are included in the package.
